Dear Mr. Duarte:

In regards to the abuse on staff, made by you, that occurred on Finger 2 in the south basin of the Campbell River Harbour Authority on the morning of February 17, 2010.

CRHA is requesting that you make alternate arrangements for the berthing of the vessel Acor as per the CRHA berthage agreement that you signed on May 28, 2008:

Section 4, item B:

(b) to berth and operate the Vessel and to maintain the Vessel and berth area in a seamanlike manner and not to do or permit anything to be done by the crew which in the opinion of the Authority may be, or become, a nuisance or disturbance;

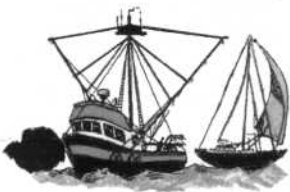
Please make alternate arrangements for the berthing of the Acor by February 28, 2010.

Mr. Duarte,

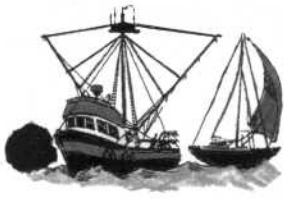
In a letter from CRHA delivered on February 18, 2010 you were requested to remove your vessel the "Acor" from the harbour by February 28, 2010.

You can obtain the answers to your questions 1 and 4 from Industry Canada.

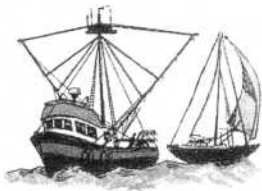
The answers to questions 2 and 3 are subject to privacy legislation which governs the operation for the CRHA and cannot be provided.

The directors will deny you access to board meetings until you demonstrate a willingness to work for positive outcomes for all harbour users.

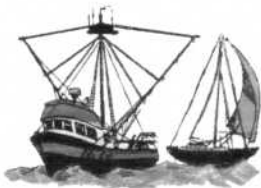
